The Championship shall take place in Terracina, Italy on April 22 - 24, 2005 according to the following program:

Thursday April 21st, 2005:

- A. competitors competition entry fee: Euro 100,00

Prices include the following:

- championship ID card
- accommodation **including full board** arrangement breakfast, lunch and dinner prices are per person per day sharing a double or triple room (no drinks included)
- transportation on Friday, Saturday and Sunday to and from Hotel Sport Stadium (distance 3 km)
- free training facilities on Thursday April 21st from 15.00 18.00 hrs <u>no transportation</u>
- free entrance to the party on Sunday April 24th 2005
- medical assistance during the competition days (only for competitors)

In order to officiate in the Championship each country shall book the hotel accommodation through the organization committee of the championship.

Those countries not booking the hotel accommodation through the organization committee of the championship shall pay Euro 100,00 per person in order to receive the ID card.

Junior - Individual & Team Competition:

- Two (2) Junior Black Belt competitors are allowed for individual division and/or category.
- Juniors must be born in the years from 1987 to 1992.
- Junior competitors born 1987 may either be Junior or Senior for the competition.
- Junior competitors must be 1st, 2nd and or 3rd degree Black Belt holders.
- Junior Male Teams must consist of minimum <u>5+1</u>(optional) competitors and may consist of maximum of <u>10</u> competitors <u>not necessarily chosen out of the individual competitors</u> Any of those team members may compete in Pattern, Sparring, Special Techniques and or Power Test.
- Junior Female Team may consists of maximum 10 competitors not necessarily chosen out of the individual competitors Any of those team members may compete in Pattern, Sparring, Special Techniques and or Power Test.

Requirements of the number of competitors in team items:

- 1. Pattern competition a minimum of 5 + 1 (optional) competitors
- 2. Sparring competition a minimum of 3 + 1 (optional) competitors
- 3. Power competition a minimum of 3 + 1 (optional) competitors
- 4. Special Technique competition a minimum of 3 +1 (optional) competitors
- In Pattern competition the team members may perform any optional pattern from Chon-Ji to Choi-Yong according to the lowest degree holder member in their team.



Senior - Individual & Team Competition:

- Only one (1) Senior Black Belt competitor is allowed for individual division and/or category.
- Senior must be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and or 6th degree Black belt holders
- Senior 4^{th} , 5^{th} , and 6^{th} degree shall compete in one Pattern division from 4^{th} to 6^{th} degree in this division the highest pattern to perform remains Moon-Moo.
- Senior Male Team must consist of minimum o 5+1 (optional) competitors and may consist of maximum **10** competitors not necessarily chosen out of the individual competitors Any of those team members may compete in Pattern, Sparring, Special Techniques and or Power Test.
- Senior Female Team may consist of a maximum of 10 competitors <u>not necessarily chosen out of the individual competitors</u> Any of those team members may compete in Pattern, Sparring, Special Techniques and or Power Test.

Requirements of the number of competitors in team items:

- 1. Pattern competition a minimum of 5 + 1 (optional) competitors
- 2. Sparring competition a minimum of 3 + 1 (optional) competitors
- 3. Power competition a minimum of 3 + 1 (optional) competitors
- 4. Special Technique competition a minimum of 3 +1 (optional) competitors
- In Pattern competition the team members may perform any optional pattern from Chon-Ji to Moon-Moo according to the lowest degree holder member in their team.

Other information - Junior & Senior Competition:

- Competitors must show their ITF black belt degree ID card and national passport at the accreditation.
- Competitors must be in possession of a blue and red pair of "safe T" equipment (other colours will not be allowed).
- Competitors must have full insurance coverage for all eventualities F.I.TAE is not responsible for any injuries and other insurance cases.
- Sponsorship is allowed on the right or left or right sleeve of the dobok jacket measuring max. Length 8 cm height 5 cm.
- Medals for Female team competition shall be awarded only to those team members officiating in the various team items.

Umpires:

- Umpires will be accommodated in the Umpire/VIPs hotel
- The organization will pay a 5 days/4 nights hotel accommodation including full board from Thursday April 21st 2005 to Monday April 25th 2005 to a maximum of two (2) Umpires for each participating country.
- Other Umpires wishing to participate must pay their hotel accommodation according above mentioned arrangements.
- Umpires must attend the umpire meeting on Thursday April 21st,2005 at 19.30 hrs in the Umpire Hotel dressed as written in the ITF Umpire rules.
- Umpires <u>not present</u> at the umpire meeting on Thursday April 21st, 2005 at 19.30 hrs shall be removed from the umpire list and be accommodated in the competitors hotel they therefore shall pay their own expenses.
