## AETF CONGRESS 2011

On 20<sup>th</sup> October 2011 at the City Hotel Bratislava the AETF Congress took place in which the representatives of 33 countries participated, out of which 30 had the voting rights, as follows: Austria, Armenia, Belgium, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, England, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Luxembourg, Moldova, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Romania, Russia, Scotland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine and Wales. At the meeting 8 AETF Board of Directors and 3 Members of AETF Revisory Committee were present and the following guests: Master Juan Fernando, ITF Secretary General and GM Willem Jacob Bos, ITF Board of Director, Master Per Andressen and Master

Per Christian Garnæs from Norway, Mr. Stephen Ryan and Mr. Adrian Byrne from Ireland, Mr. Slavko Jereb and Mr. Ernest Hedegus from Croatia, Mr. Zvezdan Milenkovic and Mr. Andrijan Tasic from Serbia and Mr. Parviz Mamedov from Kazakhstan. AETF Congress:  
- approved the report of activity of the President from 2010 and financial report,  
- the AETF Competition Rules were unified with ITF Competition Rules,  
- the application from ITF Kazakhstan Association for membership in AETF was rejected,  
- the delegates gave the right to host Euros 2012 to Slovenian Taekwon-Do Association led by Mr. Tomaz Barada, which will be held in Maribor, Slovenia from 19<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> April



- delegates were bombarded with the amount of invitations for Open Competitions, including World Cup 2012 to be held in Brighton, and for seminars and courses,  
- there was also presentation of new educational computer programmes regarding Taekwon-Do,  
- there was presentation of the Taekwon-Do games and the offer of Mr. Andrzej Undro regarding Taekwon-Do gadgets like pins, pendants, T-shirts and other merchandising products,  
- and also delegates discussed many other subjects

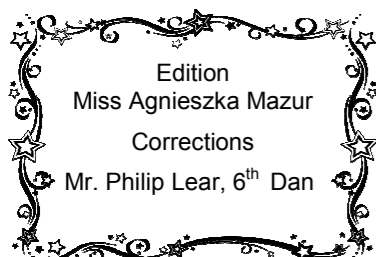
