## HARD-WORKING TIME FOR BD MEMBERS

### CHANGES IN THE AETF COMPETITION RULES

There were two AETF BD Directors meetings held earlier this year. The first took place on January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010 in Lublin, Poland, where many decisions were made. One of the most important and interesting for the competitors, umpires and the spectators are changes in the AETF Competition rules, which are as follows:

#### Section 2 Pattern

#### Article 28 Eliminations - junior and senior - team

The pyramid system of elimination will be used.

1. Designated pattern draw will take place whilst both teams are on the floor.

From the second round of the draw a coin will be tossed to decide which team goes first. The winning coach of the toss decides which team performs as first.

Below is procedure the teams have to follow to perform patterns:

Chosen team (red) performs optional pattern, second team (blue) performs optional pattern.

Team (red) performs designated pattern, team (blue) performs designated pattern.

2. Evaluating of the team patterns by the referees begins when the performance starts. Entering and leaving the mats is not marked.

#### Section 6 Pre-arranged free sparring Article 49 Divisions

Male, Female and/or Mixed  
Couples  
JUNIOR AND SENIOR

#### Article 50 Procedure

Two (2) participants follow a prepared scenario that enables them to skilfully exhibit a wide variety of techniques without fear of injury.

They shall participate according the following rules and regulations:

a) Competitors may be from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> degree.

b) Competitors may be Male, Female and or Mixed Couples.

c) Duration of one (1) round: minimum 50 seconds – maximum 60 seconds.

d) Pre arranged free sparring shall consist of movements as show in the ITF Encyclopaedia, Manuals, CD Rom and as taught in the International

Instructor Courses.

e) No protection gear may be worn.

f) In the event of a tie teams will compete once more until the places are decided.

#### Article 51 Officials for pre-arranged free sparring

One (1) Jury President, two (2) Jury Members and five (5) Referees.

Approved by the AETF Board of Directors on January 16<sup>th</sup> 2010r

Ratified by the AETF Congress on April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2010

### NO TO ALCOHOL

The subject of drinking alcohol by juniors during AETF European Championships and Cup was raised and as a result of a discussion BD members agreed to add to the invitation for the European Cups and Championships the following statement showing that our organization is totally against such a behavior:

"The AETF would like to state strongly that they will not be responsible for any actions resulting in the abuse of alcohol during any AETF sanctioned event (including the Post Championships party). However if any individual over the age of 18 is deemed to bring ITF Taekwon-Do, the AETF or their country into disrepute as a result of alcohol then they and the responsible person for that country may face disciplinary procedures. Also if any junior (even aged 18 years) is found drinking alcohol during any AETF sanctioned event (including the Post Championships party) then they and the responsible person for that country may also face disciplinary procedures."

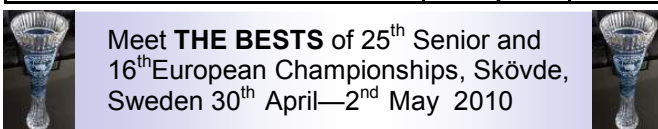
