AETF HONORARY PRESIDENT

On 21st October 2011, at the ITF Congress held in Bratislava, Slovakia during the European Open Cup, Mr Luis Baguena Salvador was nominated as the Honorary A.E.T.F. President as an expression of gratitude for his hard work, dedication and contribution to the organisational development of Taekwon-Do ITF in Europe in the past as well as extremely big knowledge and experience in leading many international organizations, which he may share with us. Mr Baguena is a 79-year old retired colonel of Safety Forces In Spain; Ph.D. of Economy, former lecturer at University of Madrid, founder of Martial Arts Spanish Federation and its first President, co-founder of Spanish Judo Federation and International Judo Federation President between 1991 and 1995, well-known sports activist in many sport organisations on the international level. Mr. Luis Baguena was elected AETF President on the AETF Congress held in Madrid, Spain, on 18th November 1988, when also on the motion put by Mr. Tony Nobilo from Yugoslavia the name of the Federation was changed into European

Taekwon-Do Federation. At the AETF Congress held on 13th May 1994 in Lublin, Poland on the motion put by Mr. Luis Baguena the name of the Federation was



changed into European Taekwon-Do Union. According to his explanation it would possibly help to get recognition from international sport organisation. Particularly, Master Rhee Ki Ha was against the new name, because it was the same as WTF. Later on there were many requests from Master Rhee Ki Ha and gen. Choi Hong Hi to change the name again to AETF, during the Congress held on 27th January 1996, where Mr. Luis Baguena was re-elected by the Congress as the President, the name ETU was preserved. This was the direct cause of ITF interference. On 10th April 1966 ITF as a Supreme Body change this resolution. Upon the decision made by Gen Choi, Master Georgios Stylianidis from Greece was elected President, what definitely was not the proper way of behaviour. More and more Grand Masters in EUROPE!

Master Kim Ung Lan and Master Rolf Becking joined the elitists Club of Grand Masters in Europe, till now having only two members, i.e. to GM Tom MacCallum IXth Degree from England and GM Willem Jacob Bos, IXth Degree from Italy.



Rolf Becking

He started ITF Taekwon-Do in Germany in 1968 and was one of the first practitioners in Germany being promoted as an International Instructor (4th degree). Since that time he is a active member of ITF-Deutschland. He was also a very successful competitor in pattern and sparring.

In the early days of ITF-Taekwon-Do in Germany he was always the interpreter at the IIC 's with General Choi whenever he visited Germany. Therefore he had good relations to General Choi and also a big acceptance by him.

Master Rolf Becking was and still is one of the key-persons of the ITF in Germany. He is the Chairman of the Technical Committee of the ITF-Deutschland since 1989 and due to his technical capacity and personality he is very well accepted and respected.

Kim Ung Lan

He started ITF Taekwon-Do in Vietnam 1965. He moved to Germany in 1969 (where he studied mechanical engineering). After had graduated he has studied physical education and economics for two years. Since 1969 he has been training with many ITF-Masters and eventually with General Choi.

Master Kim-Lan Ung was and still is one of the key-persons of the ITF in Germany. Since 1991 he is one of the national coaches with a great success. Many of his students (male and female) became German, European and World Champions. He also was a very good fighter and he won many national and international titles. He conducts seminars around the world.
