3. PLACE AND TIME OF EVENT

The 27th Senior and 18th Junior European Taekwon-do Championships – ITF will take place between the 19th and 22nd April 2012 in Maribor, Slovenia. It will take place in the sports hall 'LUKNA', Mladinska 29, Maribor. Sports hall web page: http://www.zveza-msdbranik.si

4. REGISTRATION

On-line registration for all teams, such as data input, creation of ID-cards must be made at the entry point of the competition organiser, all changes and explanations must always be forwarded to the organising committee's e-mail: itfeurochamp2012@gmail.com as well as to the All Europe Taekwon-do Federation (AETF) office e-mail: info@itfeurope.org.

5. ARRIVAL DATE AND MEETING POINT

All participating countries should arrive to Maribor no later than on April 19th 2012 before 14.00 pm. Of course all teams are welcome to arrive before this date.

The meeting point for accreditation and all payments will be in Hotel Piramida which is located in the central part of Maribor.

Each country is responsible for its own expenses while attending the Championships and the expenses made by their team members.

6. CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

The championship will use the official rules of the INTERNATIONAL TAEKWON-DO FEDERATION, version May 1^{st} 2010.

8.1 Divisions - Categories:

The championships will be performed separately for seniors and juniors.

 The age of the competitors is dictated by their year of birth, this means that a competitor who is 13 years old and will turn 14 years on 31st December 2012 may









compete. It also means that a Junior who is 18 years old on 1st January 2012 may compete as a junior or as a senior.

• Each country may enter up to 3 Juniors for each event.

Competition is divided into INDIVIDUAL and TEAM matches.

Pattern and Sparring events will be decided by the pyramid tournament system.

Power Tests, Special Techniques and Pre-arranged free sparring events will be decided by the highest point obtained.

INDIVIDUAL

JUNIOR - Individual match is divided into:

Pattern Male/Female – I, II and III Degree divisions

Sparring Male/Female

Micro, Light, Middle, Heavy, Hyper weight divisions

Power Male/Female Special Technique Male/Female

SENIOR - Individual match is divided into:

Pattern Male/Female – I, II, IV to VI Degree divisions

Sparring Male/Female

Micro, Light, Middle, Heavy, Hyper weight divisions

Power Male/Female Special Technique Male/Female

N.B.: Individual competitors may enter all items.

TEAM

Junior and Senior Team match is divided into:

Pattern Male/Female
Sparring Male/Female
Power Male/Female
Special Technique Male/Female

Each team may perform in Pattern, Sparring, Power Special Techniques and Pre-Arranged Sparring.

In Sparring competitors may be of any weight.

COMPETITORS NUMBERS - INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM

INDIVIDUAL JUNIOR

The number of individual junior competitors who may enter each discipline is restricted to three (3) persons from each country.

These competitors may be individuals or team members.

INDIVIDUAL SENIOR

The number of individual senior competitors who may enter each discipline is restricted to one (1) person from each country.

These competitors may be individuals or team members.











TEAM (Male and Female)

Teams may consist of a maximum of ten (10) competitors. (NOT NECESSARILY CHOSEN OUT OF THE INDIVIDUAL COMPETITORS)

Male

Out of the ten (10) competitors a minimum of 5 competitors + 1 reserve (optional) may compete in Pattern, Sparring,

Special Technique and Power events.

Changes of the team competitors are not allowed once they have been indicated for the various team events.

<u>Female</u>

Out of the ten (10) competitors a minimum of 5 competitors + 1 reserve (optional) may compete in Pattern and Sparring events.

A minimum of 3 competitors + 1 reserve (optional) may compete in Special Technique and Power events.

Changes of the team competitors are not allowed once they have been indicated for the various team events.

8.2 Registration of the competitors











Registration of the competitors will be coordinated by the All Europe Taekwon-do Federation (AETF) office.

The registration will be done only on-line and it will close on April 15^{th} 2012 at 24:00. Countries that encounter difficulties with data input should use the attached table 'Application form' and attach competitors pictures in .JPG or.PNG form, size 3,5 x 4,5 cm.

Passwords for access to the application will be sent to all the member countries via e-mail by the All Europe Taekwon-do Federation (AETF) office. Please follow the instructions for registration to avoid unnecessary complications.

Warning: Every change in the registration after the official deadline will result in an additional fee of 25 EUR per each individual change.

7. EQUIPMENT REGULATIONS

- All participants must wear the official ITF dobok from one of the approved companies (Top Ten, Top Pro, Fuji Mae, Gran Marc) or has been officially approved by the ITF.
- In sparring competition only protection gear manufactured by TOP TEN is allowed.
- All competitors will use sparring protection gear in red or blue colour depending on the draw.
- All competitors (Seniors and Juniors) must wear an approved head guard for sparring.

Attention!

The championship organiser will provide equipment for rent for all those without proper protection gear.

8. INSURANCE

The Organising Committee of the European Championships 2012 will not be financially responsible for possible injuries caused during the competition. All competitors must have full insurance coverage from their own organization / country.

COMPETITORS - TEAM COMPETITION ENTRY FEES:

Individuals: 100 EUR

Teams: 50 EUR

Team Pre Free Arranged Sparring: free of charge

Entry fees include:

Identification card, which is mandatory for the championship as an official document for identifying competitors, coaches, umpires and staff. The card is acquired when payment for the accommodation done through the championship organiser.

9.1 Accommodation Reservations:

Please note that the accommodation will not be officially accepted until the requested amount has reached the organisers account.

Step three:

When the organiser receives the requested amount for the preliminary booking they will contact the responsible person and deliver the receipt for the accommodation's full amount. The remaining 50% difference in amount must be paid by April 5th 2012.

Changing the reservations

Until April 10th 2012 it is possible to make small changes in the reservations, in case of price differentiation you will receive the receipt for the difference, which must be paid immediately. After this date no additional changes can be made.

Attention!

All participating countries must make accommodation reservations exclusively through the organising committee. In case a participating country acts contrary to the instructions, it cannot compete in the championship.

10.UMPIRES

The Organising board will pay hotel accommodations for 5 days/ 4 nights, including full board (no drinks included), from Thursday April 19th 2012 to Monday April 23rd 2012 for a maximum of two (2) umpires from each participating country, by the following criteria:

- 1. Countries with 0-4 competitors may bring one (1)Umpire (no obligation)
- 2. Countries with 5-15 competitors must bring one (1)Umpire
- 3. Countries with 15+ competitors must bring two (2) Umpires
- 4. Countries that do NOT bring an Umpire shall pay a fine of Euros €750 for each missing Umpire according to points b or c. These amounts shall be used for the development of Tournament &Umpire Committee.

Umpires will be accommodated in double rooms. Umpires wishing to use a single room will be charged the difference in price for a single room.









Other umpires wishing to participate must pay their own hotel accommodations according to the above mentioned arrangements.

All umpires must attend the umpire meeting on Thursday April 19th 2012 at 15:00 – 17:00 in the Umpire Hotel. Umpires must be dressed as written in the ITF Umpire rules.

Umpires not present at the umpire meeting on Thursday April 19th 2012 at 15:00 will be removed from the umpire list and will pay their own expenses.

11.COACHES

During competition all coaches must wear sports clothes (training suit, T-shirt and pants and running shoes). Coaches in the competition area are not allowed to be dressed differently than required.

Only one (1) coach from each country is allowed in the coaching zone, other coaches must remain outside this coaching zone.

Only a present coach can make an official protest.

Please follow the instructions and make sure that only a maximum of two coaches can be present at the umpire meeting on Thursday April 19^{th} 2012 at 17:30 - 20:00.

12.VISA

The organising board has notified the Slovenian embassies and consulates about the European championship. If you require a visa you must turn to the Slovenian embassy or consulate in your country. In case any issues arise turn to the organising board. To easily check which countries require a visa for Slovenia and which do not, please visit the Ministry Of Internal Affairs web site, where you will find all the necessary information about visas: http://www.mzz.gov.si/en/

The organising board will send a letter of guarantee for participating teams that require a visa for Slovenia but only on demand from the participating teams. - Half-year vignette for motorcycles 25,00 EUR
- Weekly vignette for motorcycles 7,50 EUR

Please pay extra attention to speed limits because the fines in Slovenia are very high and the speed limits are:

Car

Settlement: 50 km/h
 Regional road: 90 km/h
 Expressway: 100 km/h
 Highway: 130 km/h

Bus

Settlement: 50 km/h
Regional road: 80 km/h
Expressway: 80 km/h
Highway: 80 km/h

In Slovenia it is also mandatory to:

- Use lights during daytime;
- Use seatbelts on all seats where seatbelts are installed;
- Use of proper motorcycle helmet for drivers and passengers on motorcycles;
- Use of fog lamps is allowed only if the visibility is reduced by more then 50%.

Degree of alcohol in blood

Drivers of the A and B category can have a maximum of 0,5 grams of alcohol per kilogram in their blood, conditioned that they do not display drunken behaviour at lower values of alcohol.

14. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

It is strictly forbidden to take any illegal stimulants that are against the rules of the ITF Anti-doping regulations.

The organiser will have anti-doping tests on randomly chosen winners. Each athlete found positive by the test will be sanctioned according to the ITF Anti-doping regulations.

16.FLAG ANG NATIONAL ANTHEM

Each participating country must bring 2 (two) flags, size 90×130 cm and a CD with their national anthem. The flag and CD are handed in at registration and will be returned to each participant after the competition.
