
# Irish Taekwon-Do Association 2006 Review of Activities


# **February**

Saturday 13th May 2006 was an **historic day** for ITF Taekwon-Do in Ireland. Ireland's two ANAs (Allied National Associations) completed a merger process which took many months of hard work to coordinate. The Irish Taekwon-Do Association, is a democratic organisation which

now comprises 38 clubs nationwide, covering; Dublin, Meath, Carlow, Wicklow, Wexford, Cork, Galway, Kerry, Waterford, Limerick, Clare and Tipperary. The Organisation is affiliated to the ITF and AETF and is a member of the Irish Martial Arts Commission (IMAC) and is therefore recognised by the Irish Sports Council.



# Open Challenge Cup, Gent, Belgium

14 Irish competitors participated in the Open Challenge Cup in Belgium on 28th May 2006. There were clubs from 6 countries competing; Belgium, Netherlands, Germany, Ireland, Portugal and Moldova. It was a big success for the Irish Taekwon-Do Association bringing home

**The 2nd ITF Taekwon-Do World Cup,** which ran from 27th-29th October 2006, was the largest ever championships in the history of the ITF with over 850 competitors participating from all over the world. It was also the most successful championships in the history of Irish Taekwon-Do with an unprecedented 34 medals brought home to Ireland. The Irish Taekwon-Do Association (ITA) brought home 32 medals including; 8 Gold, 6 Silver and 18 Bronze, reaching the podium in every discipline, in both individual and team events.

The venue for next year's Irish Cup International will be the National Basketball Arena in Dublin on 24th-25th November 2007. Next year's event promises to be even bigger with the possibility of professional bouts and television coverage currently in negotiation with interested sponsors.
