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Room rates for University On-Campus Apartments

****We have been able to secure a cheaper rates as follows**

Single basis - €37 per person (no breakfast) or €42 with breakfast

Double basis - €65 per room (no breakfast) or €75 with breakfast

Please note, there is no twin basis.

- Participants will be able to stay in apartments with their own friends/travelling group.
- Each person/couple will have their own ensuite bedroom with double bed at a substantially cheaper price than the hotel (all rooms are locked similar to hotels accessible by use of a key card).
- Apartments all have a kitchen a living room area (The kitchen is equipped with cutlery, pots knives etc...)
- Apartments can have 2, 4 or 6 bedrooms so based on the size of the group travelling, the most appropriate size apartments can be chosen.

Breakfast is continental style. A large basket of fresh fruit, bread, tea, coffee, milk and cereal is delivered to the apartment.

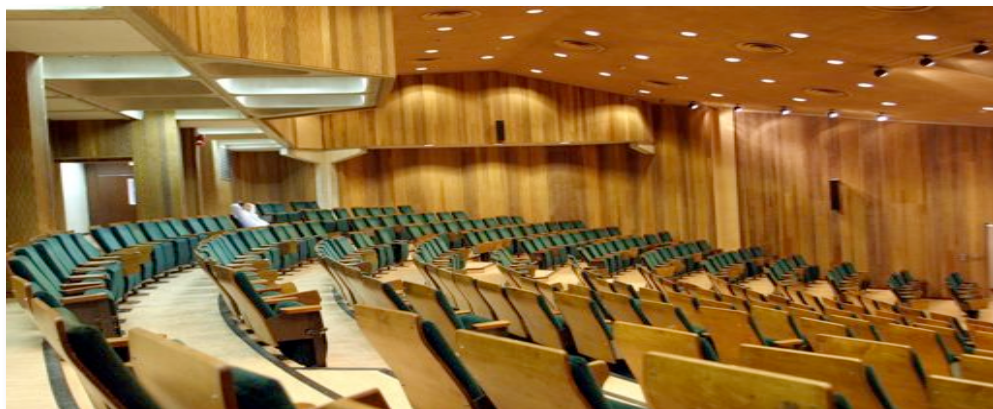
Please note that the complete fees (course, accommodation, BBQ) have to be paid to the organizing team at your arrival in the hotel. We only accept EURO currency.

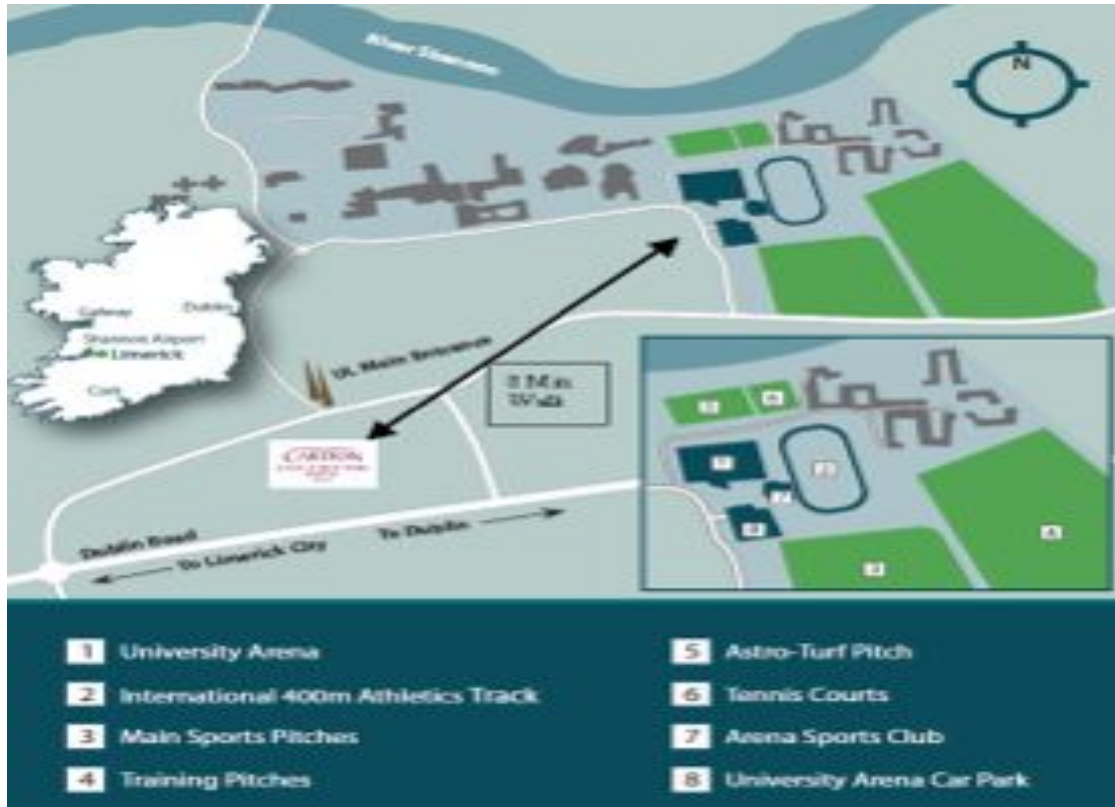

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Located on Ireland's longest waterway, the river Shannon, Limerick is Ireland's oldest chartered city having received its charter in 1197. Conquered by the Vikings in the 9th Century and besieged by the English in 1691, the city is rich in history and has many historic buildings to view including King John's Castle and Hunt Museum.

A city famed for sport, Limerick is proud of its rugby tradition and its strength in hurling and Gaelic football. The city offers a cultural programme of music and visual arts as well as excellent shops and a choice of good restaurants and lively bars.



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The Shannon Region and Beyond

Limerick offers a superb base for touring the attractions of the Shannon region and beyond. Visitors can enjoy tours to the spectacular Cliffs of Moher and the Atlantic Coast, the highest cliff scenery in Europe, and the Burren region – an unusual area of limestone karst rock, which has archaeological and geological interest.

Day tours to Killarney and Galway are also possible while closer to Limerick are the renowned outdoor attractions of the Bunratty folk park and Craggaunowen bronze age site. Golf, hiking and horse riding are all available and within easy reach of the IUC campus.



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
